## How to Sign up and Adopt a Catch Basin

1. Open the App from the City of Hamilton Adopt a Catch Basin website



- 2. Enter your email and click **Login/Sign Up**
- 3. More fields will become available to you. Your name and address are required. Your phone number is optional. Enter the information and click **Sign Up**

4. A window will pop up letting you know that a login link has been emailed to you. Click **OK** and **close the Adopt a Catch Basin app**.



5. Go to your email and you will find the Welcome email. This will serve as your personal access to use the application. Don't worry if you lose the email, there is another way to gain access. (More on that later). Click **Login** so that you may begin to Adopt!



- 6. The **Login** link will reopen the Adopt a Catch Basin app. You can zoom and pan or enter an address in the box at the top of the screen to make it easier to find a catch basin.
- Click on a catch basin that is available (Green), enter a personalized nickname and click Adopt (this nickname will be viewable by the public, so we ask that you please keep it clean).

**Cleaned, Damaged, or Clogged** (Select **Abandon** if you decide you no longer want this catch basin)
